Minimum Qualifications

An earned Ph.D. (ABD will be considered; degree must be earned before date of hire) in civil engineering or a closely related field, specializing in the area of coastal engineering and hydraulics. Demonstrated ability as a teacher.

Potential to obtain competitive research grants.
Excellent communication skills for meeting and conferring with others.

Desirable Qualifications

Research focused on the following thrust areas in coastal engineering as applicable to the state of Hawai'i and Pacific islands such as (a) coastal water quality modeling, pollution mitigation and management; (b) prediction and mitigation of natural and man-made hazards, sustainable coastal development; (c) utilization of coastal resources for development of aquaculture or renewable energy, and (d) eco-hydrology, eco-hydraulics, and hydro-informatics.
