### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

The successful candidate will teach a minimum of 3 courses per semester, or 6 courses per academic year. The number of courses taught will depend on the time required to perform the duties of the faculty in achieving the objectives of the Construction Engineering program. In so far as possible, the courses should include some or all of the following topics or any other suitable topics that will better prepare students for a career in infrastructure construction:

- 1. Construction Estimating and Bidding (CEE 474)
- 2. Construction Planning and Scheduling (CEE 476)
- 3. Construction Project Management (CEE 472)
- 4. Construction Methods (CEE 471)
- 5. Construction Equipment and Methods (CEE 473)
- 6. Construction Law (CEE 479)
- 7. Construction Safety (CEE 478)

The faculty member will serve on appropriate Department, College, and/or University committees and provide service to the construction, engineering, and architecture communities.

The faculty member will assist in the curriculum development for the current Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering and Construction Engineering, as well as advising the University on curriculum content for a potentially new Construction Management degree or certificate program.

#### Minimum Qualifications:

- A Master's degree in construction management, civil engineering, architecture or related field or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- At least three years of experience in construction engineering, construction management or related field.
