The University of Kentucky Office of the Vice President for Research is seeking experienced candidates currently employed by the University of Kentucky to apply for the position of Director of the Tracy Farmer Institute for Sustainability and the Environment (TFISE). This senior level position reports to the Vice President for Research and is responsible for administration of the TFISE, including managing a \$200K operating budget and a \$5.1M endowment portfolio, personnel, research programs, productivity, and program prioritization. The Director will develop strategic plans for TFISE and new research, service, and facility programs; develop resources for new priorities and conduct research activities to develop new programs.

Qualified candidates will have a PhD and at least 10 years of related environmental research experience. Candidates should have an established research program, budget management experience, excellent communication skills, and leadership experience. Additional strengths will include
