Minimum Qualifications

Required qualifications include:

- Master's degree in Construction Management, Architecture, Engineering, or a related field, with a minimum of 5 years' experience in the US construction industry, at the time employment begins.

OR

- Bachelor's degree in Construction Management, Architecture, Engineering, or a related field, with a minimum of 10 years' experience. At least 5 years of this experience shall be in the US construction industry, at the time employment begins.
