Candidates with experience and expertise in all areas of biomedical and/or biosystems engineering will be considered, but strength in sensors, robotics in medicine, advanced prosthetics, and big data analytics (e.g. omics technologies and imaging informatics) are particularly desirable.

Essential duties and responsibilities:

Candidates will be expected to teach in the Biomedical Engineering (BME) and Bio-systems Engineering (BSE) curricula, conduct research, and advise undergraduate and graduate students. They must establish a strong record of research, teaching, and service

Minimum Qualifications:

A Ph.D. in Biomedical or Bio-systems Engineering or a closely related discipline, as well as excellent verbal and writing skills, are required. Applicants must have a strong commitment to teaching excellence, scholarly production, and grantsmanship and should have the ability to conduct multi-disciplinary collaborative research.
