Duties and Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will teach 2-3 courses per semester, or 4-6 courses per academic year, as needed, and as instructed by the Department Chair. The number of courses taught will depend on the time required to perform the duties of the faculty in achieving the objectives of the Construction Engineering program.
