The successful applicant will be required to teach, advise, and mentor graduate and undergraduate students; develop and maintain an independent, externally funded research program; participate in all aspects of the department's activities; and serve the profession. The Department of Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) at Texas A&M is currently one of 15 departments in the College of Engineering. Our student population comprises over 1,700 undergraduate students (sophomores to seniors) and nearly 700 graduate students. The department is housed in the recently renovated Peterson Building, with airy modern offices, conference rooms, and lounges equipped with state-of-the-art A/V technology.
