# Civil & Environmental Engineering Assistant or Associate Professor - Sustainable Communities and Infrastructure Position

The Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering (CEE) at the University of Houston invites applications for one full-time tenured or tenure-track faculty position in all areas related to sustainable communities and infrastructure. The appointment is open the Assistant or Associate rank, with particular interest in sustainable, resilient and smart environmental, transportation, water, and building systems. This includes but is not limited to; climate adaptation and resilience; wastewater and solid waste technologies; innovative solutions based on the combination of large data, sensor technology, and machine learning approaches; and near-zero-energy buildings. Candidates applying at the Associate rank are expected to demonstrate nationally and internationally recognized scholarly activities with a strong record of externally funded research. The candidates must also demonstrate a commitment towards teaching at both undergraduate and graduate levels.

<u>University and Department:</u> The University of Houston is located in a park-like campus a few minutes from downtown Houston with over 34,000 undergraduate students and nearly 8,000 graduate students. The CEE department currently has 25 tenured or tenure-track faculty members. Houston is the fourth largest city in the U.S. with over 6.8 million in population. It is the "energy capital of the world" and houses the largest medical center in the world. The greater Houston area offers state-of-the-art recreational facilities, world-class arts and cultural activities, excellent schools, and affordable housing.
