The candidate's research area should extend or complement the current research areas in the Department, including Biorefining & Bioproducts, Biomedical, Energy Storage and Environment, Coating & Printing, Nanomaterials, Pulp & Paper, and Paper Recycling & Sustainability. Preference for the position will be given to a candidate with demonstrated excellence or promise of excellence in research.
