Willingness and flexibility to teach both a variety of mechanical engineering including introductory engineering and general education courses is desired, as well as an interest in participating in the school's unique global engineering course and field experience. Additional responsibilities include advising mechanical engineering students, industrial outreach leading to student internship and employment opportunities, engaging in professional development and scholarly activities, and participation in faculty governance.
