ME280, Graphic Communications, is a required 2-credit course that provides students a broad introduction to technical sketching, two-and-three-dimensional visualization, blueprint reading, and ASME standards, NX parametric solid modeling, component drawings, and complex assembly structures.

Candidates must have the ability to teach ME280, effectively communicate with undergraduate students, and work with graduate teaching assistants. The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching academic-year offerings of ME280 and another 200-level mechanical engineering undergraduate courses. The anticipated teaching load will be 8-9 course credit hours per semester during the academic year.
