University of Sharjah (AUS) invites applications for a regular or visiting faculty position, preferably at the assistant or associate professor level, commencing in Fall 2024. The successful candidate for the regular position will be expected to establish a high-level, active research program supported by internal and external funding sources. The visiting faculty position is primarily focused on teaching. The visiting position is a one-year renewable contract and the regular position is a three-year renewable contract.

The applicant is required to have a PhD degree in Electrical Engineering with preferably a focus in the area of control engineering and good hands-on experience. Expertise in the areas of robotics and automation, embedded systems, intelligent systems, cyber-physical systems and mechatronics is a plus.

The candidate should show evidence of excellence in teaching and research. In addition, experience in the American model of higher education is highly desirable.

The required documents are a cover letter and a detailed curriculum vitae (including a teaching statement, a research statement, list of courses that can be taught or were taught, and names of at least three references who would be willing to write letters of recommendation). The position is open until filled. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted.

The Department of Electrical Engineering has approximately 205 undergraduate students, 43 graduate students, 15 full-time faculty and 4 lab instructors. Faculty and students represent very diverse backgrounds and nationalities; approximately 90 nationalities are present on campus.
