Excellent interpersonal and communication skills with desire and ability to work constructively, decisively, and collegially with external and internal colleagues and interdisciplinary teams.

We seek individuals with the ability to work independently: proactive self-starter with strong project leadership skills.

A successful candidate will display innovative thinking, open to sharing ideas and willing to continuously learn.

Candidates should indicate areas of teaching strength within computer science in their application. We will consider applicants in all areas of computer science, and especially welcome applicants with teaching strengths in introductory programming, software engineering, discrete mathematics, algorithms, computer architecture, and operating systems at the undergraduate level.
